1. ENTRY DETAILS:

- Closing date is Thursday 2nd March 2023, no late entries will be accepted.
- Entries must be made through SportyHQ and players must be a paid-up member of Squash SA through SportyHQ.

- The draw will be available on SportyHQ on Thursday 9th March.
- Players not attending prize giving will forfeit their prizes.

- Games for all age groups will take place over the both days.

2. RULES OF ENTRY

- Protective eyewear is compulsory.
- Players are to ensure that they are ready to play 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match time.
- Any player arriving more than 10 minutes after their scheduled play time will forfeit the match.
- Players / parents are NOT allowed to rearrange game times.
- All players must mark and referee the match after their match. Winner referee and the loser marks. Failing to mark or referee could result in disqualification.
- The private use of cell phones while marking / refereeing is forbidden.
- The PARS scoring system will be used. U11 and U13 play to 15. All other age groups play to 11.
- U11 and U13 use a yellow dot ball, all other age groups use a green dot ball.
- Joburg Junior Squash does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or belongings.
- Players agree that Joburg Junior Squash and/or SA Schools Squash may use photos/images/videos of the players for purposes such as celebrating achievement and publicising squash events and may be posted to any social media platform or the JJS website.

3. CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR

- Parents / spectators are NOT allowed to interfere with any marking or play.
- Cheering or intimidation of players during and after the match will not be tolerated.
- Players and spectators are expected to adhere to SA Squash Rules and Code of Conduct.
- Instances of misconduct will be severely sanctioned by JJS.
- No shows, late withdrawals, not marking / refereeing could result in players being banned from future tournament.
- Tournament referee's decision is final.
